About the USFAA Muzzle-Loading Artillery School:

The USFAA Muzzle-Loading Artillery School is sponsored by the Loyal Train of Artillery Chapter of the United States Field Artillery Association at Ft. Sill, Oklahoma, the home of the US Field Artillery. It teaches the drill, safety, and operation of muzzle-loading artillery to reenactors and ceremonial artillerists, as well as to those interested in learning more about muzzle-loading artillery.

The Basic Course of Instruction is also referred to as The School of the Piece. This course is designed to teach the procedures for each position of a cannon crew. Students are taught: nomenclature and care of artillery pieces and equipment; drills for loading, firing, and servicing the piece; procedures for clearing misfires; procedures for rolling, preparing, and storing charges; and, safety procedures for operating the piece and maintaining a safe firing range.
